DCF is proud to co-sponsor the 2008 Annual True Colors XV Conference: A Global Perspective on Sexual and Gender Minority Youth. This is the largest sexual and gender minority Youth conference in the Nation and people come from all across the United States to attend. Last year we had over 3400 attendees.

Due to the record number of participants last year, we have outgrown the facilities at Central Connecticut State University, so this year's conference will be held at the University of Connecticut (UConn) Storrs Campus.

The Conference begins on Thursday, March, 13, 2008 with a Pre-Conference Institute for professionals only (Clinical and Mental Health, Child Welfare, Health Care and Substance Abuse Prevention providers). This Pre-Conference Institute is sponsored by the Child Welfare League of America (CWLA). Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. each day with closing ceremonies ending about 5:30 p.m.

On Friday, March 14th and Saturday, March 15th, 2008, the conference is open to everyone (Youth, adolescents, college students, Social Workers, Therapists, Nurses, Administrators, Clinicians, School Staff, Foster Parents, Biological Parents, Mentors, etc.)
