Applicants should submit the following by May 1, 2006:

- ✚ Scholarship application form.
- ✚ If currently a student enrolled in college; official grade transcripts.
- ✚ If currently working; most recent performance appraisal or letter from direct supervisor.
- ✚ A resume that includes extracurricular activities, community involvement, volunteer work, etc.
- ✚ A one page description of your interests and aspirations in a career providing care to others.
- ✚ Two letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with the applicant academically, professionally, or within the community.
